The Trusts of the Charities

These are set out in a Charity Commission Scheme dated 20th May 1974. Six small local charities were grouped together under one body of Trustees. The income of the Charities is to be used for the relief of need within their "area of benefit" - the parishes of Longworth and Charney Bassett and the former parish of Draycott Moor as constituted on 31st March 1971

Activities during 201

The trustees met in May and November and made a grant of £300 to Kingsmoor Day Centre for the elderly and also a grant of £100 towards hospital travelling expenses for a couple from Longworth

Financial Situation

At 31st December 2016 the bank account balances were £84.16 on current account with Barclays Bank, Abingdon and £908.48 with the Charities Official Deposit Fund. There were no debts. These balances represent accumulated income.

The permanent endowments from which the Charities derive income are invested in income units in the Charities Official Investment Fund in the names of each of the constituent charities. Additional income units were purchased out of accumulated income in 2011 and 2013. These 280.82 units are designated "non-endowment" and can, if required be sold and the proceeds used as income.
