

Helping Hands 4 Villages

The charity 'Helping Hands 4 Villages' was launched in May 2018, and covers the 4 villages of Longworth, Hinton Waldrist, Kingston Bagpuize and Southmoor. It was set up to provide help for local residents, and in particular to help the elderly, the ill, the lonely and those who may benefit from some extra support at home. In particular, the charity provides a bookable transport scheme helping people to get to hospital and doctors' appointments, as well as getting them to local day-care centres and other social events in our villages. The charity also provides a befriending scheme, whereby volunteers visit people in their homes, and have time to sit and chat. Volunteers will also undertake shopping and picking up prescriptions, together with small maintenance jobs (such as changing light bulbs or light gardening work) and help with paperwork. The charity is part of the Good Neighbour Scheme Network run by Volunteer Link-up in Witney, and this means that we can guarantee that phone requests for help will be answered by an experienced administrator between 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 pm. Monday to Friday.
